Thank you for registering online to attend today's worship service.

We are keeping the sanctuary doors open during services to allow for better air flow, so we are asking people not to gather and meet in the lobby to respect those worshipping.

- ❖ We will not pass an offering basket, but if you wish to give an offering you can drop it in the offering box in the lobby on your way in or out.
- ❖ If you wish to visit with someone after church, we ask you to visit outside following the worship service.
