Text to Give – how to set it up:

- ◆ Enter the CoH 10-digit GivePlus Text number (844-904-2282) and the amount you wish donate, then press send.
- ◆ You will receive a registration link. Click the link and enter your contact and payment information. Tap “Process.”

Give+ App – how to set it up:

- ◆ On your phone or device search and download the app called: GivePlus+
- ◆ Type in our church name or zip code (97070) and our church will pop up, select our church
- ◆ Next, you can set up your login (if you already have a Vanco giving account, you will use the same login)
- ◆ Next, you can enter your offering, you can also select funds, frequency, etc.
- ◆ The next time you go in, it will be super easy.

“How To Overcome the Devil”

(Part 1)

Revelation 10-11

Sunday, April 11, 2021

Question of the Day: *What is something you love to eat, but either can't eat it anymore or “you have to be careful!”?*

I. The book of Revelation reminds us that we are in a war, an invisible war, a spiritual battle against the powers of darkness.

- *“For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms.” (Ephesians 6:12)*
- Banished to Patmos and persecuted by the earthly powers of darkness, the apostle John now moves from being an _____ to a _____ in the book of Revelation. *“I took the little scroll from the angel's hand and ate it. It tasted as sweet as honey in my mouth, but when I had eaten it, my stomach turned sour.” (Revelation 10:10)*

II. The Two Witnesses and the time of tribulation (Revelation 11:1-14)

- *“On that day, when all the nations of the earth are gathered against her, I will make Jerusalem an immovable rock for all the nations. All who try to move it will injure themselves.” (Zechariah 12:3)*
- It is through the _____ of peace that the antichrist will deceive many people. *“While people are saying, ‘Peace and safety,’ destruction will come on them suddenly, as labor pains on a pregnant woman, and they will not escape.” (1 Thessalonians 5:3)*
- In the midst of the darkness, God will raise up two witnesses, two bright lights, who preach the gospel and cannot be stopped until they complete their mission.
- The Word of God is _____ to Christians, but it is _____ to those who do not believe. God's Word and the promises of Jesus will endure _____! *“Don't be misled-- you cannot mock the justice of God. You will always harvest what you plant.” (Galatians 6:7, NLT)*

III. The Seventh Trumpet sounds! Praise God, we know the outcome! Jesus wins! (Revelation 11:15-19)

- The seventh angel sounded his trumpet, and there were loud voices in heaven, which said: *"The kingdom of the world has become the kingdom of our Lord and of his Christ, and he will reign for ever and ever."* (Revelation 11:15)

- Who in your life has God called you to speak His truth to this week?
- What is one thing you could do this week to advance the Kingdom of God in your circle of influence?
