- ◆ Open text message on your phone and enter the CoH 10-digit GivePlus Text number (844-904-2282) and the amount you wish donate, then press send.
- ◆ You will receive a registration link. Click the link and enter your contact and payment information. Tap "Process." Follow additional instructions.

Give+ App:

- ◆ On your phone or device search and download the app called: GivePlus+
- ◆ Type in our church name or zip code (97070) and our church will pop up, select our church
- ◆ Next, set up your login (if you already have a Vanco giving account, you will use the same login)
- ◆ Next, enter your offering.

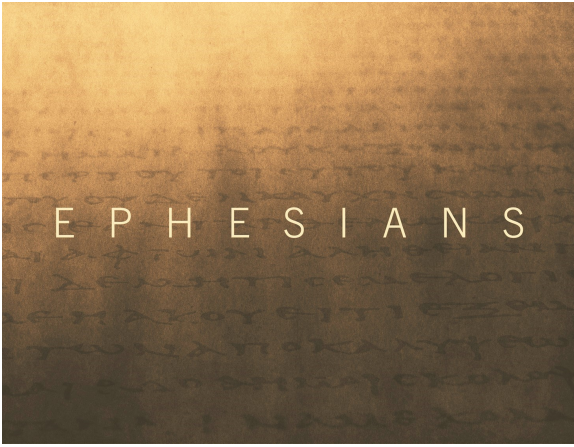

Question of the Day: *Are you a good “multi-tasker?”*

I. Paul _____ for the people in Ephesus. (Ephesians 1:15-23)

- His prayer was for them to know the _____ of all they have in Jesus Christ.
- *“I keep asking that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the glorious Father, may give you the Spirit of wisdom and revelation, so that you may know him better.”* (Ephesians 1:17)
- We all have many issues, physical and spiritual challenges, in this life. Paul’s deepest prayer for the people, however, was that they would _____ God more _____.
- The struggles we go through can be faith deepening times where we draw _____ to Him.

II. Remember these three key truths as you trust in God and in His Word today. As believers in Jesus may we have “eyes to see”...

- A greater _____ (v. 18). *“Hope is a life-shaping certainty about the future.”* (Tim Keller)
 - *“You are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people belonging to God, that you may declare the praises of him who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light.”* (1 Peter 2:9)
2. A greater _____ (v. 18). Those who are saved by grace, through Christ, are His most treasured possession.
- *“The LORD your God is with you, he is mighty to save. He will take great delight in you, he will quiet you with his love, he will rejoice over you with singing.”* (Zephaniah 3:17)

3. A greater _____ (v. 19-23). The resurrection of Jesus, from death to life, is the greatest demonstration of God's power.

- *“And if the Spirit of him who raised Jesus from the dead is living in you, he who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through his Spirit, who lives in you.”* (Romans 8:11)

- What situation am I facing right now that God could use to help me know Him more?
- Which of the three blessings of hope, worth and power do I most struggle to believe is true in my life? How can these blessings change me?
- Memory verses for the Ephesians worship series:

*“Make every effort to keep the unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace.
There is one body and one Spirit-- just as you were called to one hope when you were called--
one Lord, one faith, one baptism; one God and Father of all,
who is over all and through all and in all.”* (Ephesians 4:3-6)
