Text to Give:

- ◆ Open text message on your phone and enter the CoH 10-digit GivePlus Text number (844-904-2282) and the amount you wish donate, then press send.
- ◆ You will receive a registration link. Click the link and enter your contact and payment information. Tap "Process." Follow additional instructions.

Give+ App:

- ◆ On your phone or device search and download the app called: GivePlus+
- ◆ Type in our church name or zip code (97070) and our church will pop up, select our church
- ◆ Next, set up your login (if you already have a Vanco giving account, you will use the same login)
- ◆ Next, enter your offering.
- ◆ The next time you go in, you will be all set up and it will be super easy.

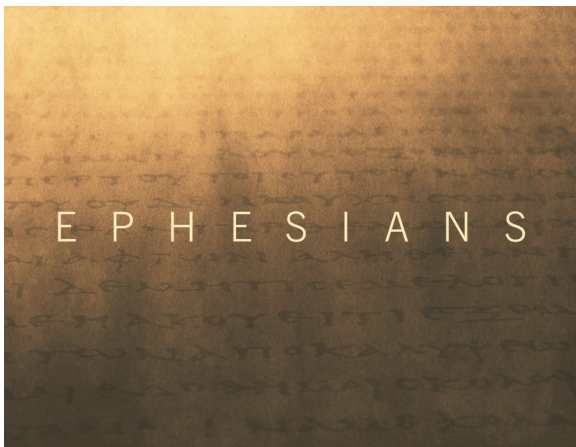


We are seeking a part-time Children's Ministry Coordinator

“Alive and at Peace in Christ”

Ephesians 2:1-22

Sunday, June 20, 2021

Question of the Day: *What is (or was) the favorite thing you like(d) to do with your dad?*

I. In Christ we are made alive! We are called to...(Eph. 2:1-10)

- Remember what we are saved _____(v. 1-3). We are brought from death to life! Our heart is “curved in on itself” (Martin Luther). We grasp for anything to give us a sense of identity.
- Remember what we are saved _____(v. 4-7). I could rebel all my life and His mercy is still enough. Jesus took the justice of God so we could receive the mercy of God.
- Remember what we are saved _____(v. 8-10). We are saved by His grace, to do good works. Live ALL of your everyday life to the glory of God.

II. In Christ we can live in peace together. (Eph. 2:11-22)

- _____is inevitable without Jesus (v. 11-12). The tension in Ephesus was clearly along ethnic and religious lines.
- _____is only possible because of Jesus (v. 13-18). Shalom = true peace. Jesus said, *“Peace I leave with you; my peace I give you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled and do not be afraid.”* (John 14:27)
- _____demonstrates the power of Jesus (v. 19-22). We are citizens of the Kingdom of God and members of the family of God. *“Yet to all who received him, to those who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God.”* (John 1:12)
- When all people of all backgrounds come together, unified in Jesus, we see the power of God!

III. To think about and apply to your life today...

- Think about this faith question...“God, what are we making today?” Are you willing to make this a daily prayer? Are you willing to go with God and do whatever God calls you to do?
- How can receiving the peace of Jesus empower me to seek peace and unity with those who are different than me?
- Who might the Lord be moving me toward in love?
- Memory verses for the Ephesians worship series:

*“Make every effort to keep the unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace.
There is one body and one Spirit-- just as you were called to one hope when you were called--
one Lord, one faith, one baptism; one God and Father of all,
who is over all and through all and in all.” (Ephesians 4:3-6)*
