Question of the Day:

When was a time you told a true story that other people found hard to believe?

“Come alive” as we celebrate the resurrection! In Jesus we come alive to His power to change our lives and transform us into a new creation.

- *“Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; the old has gone, the new has come!”* (2 Corinthians 5:17)
- By faith, the power of God is in you to live a new life. *“And if the Spirit of him who raised Jesus from the dead is living in you, he who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through his Spirit, who lives in you.”* (Romans 8:11)

The promises of Easter are for you. You are in the Easter story! As you look at those impacted on that resurrection morning, who do you identify with the most?

- Easter is for those who grieve. Remember, death _____ when Jesus _____. *“Jesus said to her, ‘I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in me will live, even though he dies.’”* (John 11:25)
- Easter is for those who believe they have failed God, or that God has failed them. _____ is His _____. Come alive to renewed faith today! *“Therefore, there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus.”* (Romans 8:1)

- Easter is for skeptics. Even Jesus’ closest followers, at first, refused to believe. *“But they did not believe the women, because their words seemed to them like nonsense.”* (Luke 24:11) Allow God to turn your _____ into _____.

Come alive today! You are in God’s story of resurrecting, changing and renewing lives.

- Jesus loves you. It wasn’t the _____ that held Him on the cross, it was His _____ for you.
- *Then Jesus told him, “Because you have seen me, you have believed; blessed are those who have not seen and yet have believed.”* (John 20:29)

- Will you answer Jesus’ call to follow Him? *“Yet to all who received him, to those who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God.”* (John 1:12)
